Genesis 1:1

- Line 1 - Our numbering system (Prime numbers 1, 3, 5, 7 are non-divisible numbers.)
- Line 2 - Ordinal numbers (There is no numbering system in Hebrew. Instead each letter represents a number.)
- Line 3 - Genesis 1:1 in Hebrew, reading from right to left
- Line 4 - English translation using the Hebrew order
- Line 5 - The total value of the letters used in each word

1. Dr. Ivan Panin spent 50 years of his life working with Bible Numerics. His original works were hand-penned on 43,000 detailed pages of analysis. These works were called Bible Numerics.
2. There are some phenomenal mathematical designs underlying both the Greek text of the New Testament and the Hebrew text of the Old Testament. Both Hebrew and Greek use the alphabet as their numbering system.
3. Every letter, word, phrase, sentence, sub-paragraph, section and book takes on a definite arithmetical sum and system. These sums are referred to as sums and equations that form a numerical encoded pattern throughout **all** the scriptures, both Old and New Testaments. Today's lesson is to help students understand what these codes are, how to find them and, finally, how to interpret them. Once you learn the basics you can test all the scriptures yourselves using the ancient Greek and Hebrew alphabets provided with this course. They are the oldest ones that Panin could find and, with minor corrections, work very well to reveal the codes that exist in the Bible.
4. The original Hebrew manuscript was written in one long string of letters with a space between each letter. There were no words, phrases, sentences or paragraphs! Some of the manuscripts were written in Aramaic and translated into Hebrew. Dr. Panin wanted to find a way to prove which writings belonged in the Bible that would prove them to be inspired by God without any disputes! When he discovered the mathematical pattern encoded in the scriptures, he knew he had found the solution to this problem! The 43,000 pages of his works were the result!

5. The result of his work was a translation of the New Testament that met the standards of the codes. It was first printed in 1914 and is still in print today. It is known as one of the top three translations. He did not try to smooth out the English language for the benefit of the reader. He did not add any alternative translations, since **they did not fit the mathematical pattern!**

6. The recurrence of the number 7 or an exact multiple of 7, in the original, is found throughout the Bible and is widely recognized. They demonstrate an intricacy of design that testifies to a supernatural origin. Many other numbers are well known, such as 3, 5, 9, 11, 12, 13, 40, 37, 73 and other prime numbers. Bible numbers and their meanings will be provided in another lesson.

7. In the early 1900's Dr. Panin offered \$100 (a lot of money in those days) to anyone who could write even one paragraph of 300 words which would reflect this same numerical pattern. Apparently, not one entry was received. It takes a Master Encoder to do it and only one fits that description, Jehovah (God).

8. The Bible is the inspired Word of God or it is not. If you believe that it is, then you need to believe all the things written in it. Here are some interesting facts to begin your journey:

Genesis 1:1

- The entire first verse has **7** Hebrew words (in the oldest example found, provided in the first chart).

- There are **28** letters in those words = (7 x 4) [**Sum of all words/letters = 37 x 73 (2701)**]

- The 3 leading nouns in the verse (*God, heaven, and earth*) have a numeric value of **777**. [**86, 395, 296 = 777**] or **(3 x 7) x 37 = 777** Other possible combinations are endless! This is just the beginning! [I found this last one myself. I am sure other people have done so as well. **No. 5 on the next page has 7 x 111**. Each student can find more of these equations! **We don't know all the ones the Dr. Panin did as they are locked up in the vaults of the Nobel Research Foundation where he won an award for his work.**]

Below are 31 discoveries that Panin made in just the first verse of Genesis!

1. The 7 words of Genesis 1:1 has 28 (7X4) letters.
2. The value of the first and last letters of the first half of the verse = 42 (7X6).
3. The value of the first and last letters of the second half = 91 (7X13).
4. The three nouns (God, Heaven and earth) is made up of 14 letters (7X2).
5. The sum of the three nouns (God, heaven and earth) equals 777 (7X111).
6. The place value of these three nouns is 147 (7X21).
7. The Hebrew verb *created* has a gematria value of 203 (7X29).
8. The first 3 words contain the subject and are made up of 14 letters.
9. The place value of these letters equals 140 (7X20).
10. Of these 14, the place value of the silent letters equals 28 (7X4).
11. And the place value of the non-silent letters equals 112 (7X16).
12. The odd numbers among the 14 = 42 (7X6).
13. Even numbers among the 14 sums to 98 (7X14).
14. Multiplying the 14 place values of letters by their order is 1,008 (7X144).
15. The four last words contain the object and also is made up of 14 letters.
16. The object "*The Heavens + the untranslatable word* has seven letters, as does the object "*and the earth*".
17. The value of the first and last letters of all words = 1,393 (7X199).
18. The sum of the first and last letters of the first and last words = 497 (7X71).
19. The value of the first & the last letters of each word between= 896 (7X128).
20. The sum of the factors of 896 = 21 (7X3).
21. The first letters of the first and last words has the value of 7.
22. The value of last letters of the first and last words equal 490 (7X70).
23. The middle word and the one before it are made up of 7 letters.
24. The middle word and the one after it are made up of 7 letters.
25. The value of the first, middle, and last letters = 133 (7X19).
26. The two digits added of the value of (86) "God" (8 + 6) = 14 (7X2).
27. The values of the letters in God added (1, 30, 5, 10, 40) = 14 (7X2).
28. The sum of the place value in the letters of "God" (1,12,5,10,13) = 14 (7X2).
29. The number of these place-values is 7.
30. Because of contractions in Hebrew (similar to the English *isn't*), the vocabulary of Gen. 1:1 is larger than the seven words of the verse. The nine-word vocabulary of Gen. 1:1 has the value of 2275 (7X325).
31. The place value of the vocabulary = 259 (7X37).

Remember: This is still only the first verse in Genesis 1:1! Thousands more equations are there to be found in the first chapter! The entire Bible is full of them, all with 7's, 8's, 9's, 11s, 13's, 37's, 73's etc.

This section takes the numbers and letters from the above chart and applies them to Genesis 1:1:

1. The first line gives the **values** of the 7 words and the 28 letters of Genesis 1:1.
2. **Word:** The 7 words of the verse.
3. **Letter:** The 28 Hebrew letters for the words.
4. **Letter No:** The English numbering system, used for PLACE location of letters and words, i.e. 1,4,7=147 means first word, fourth word and seventh word.
5. **Gematria:** The Hebrew numbering system that matches each letter of the Hebrew language for each word in this verse.
6. **Word Value:** The sum of the Gematria for each word is used for this total. 7. **This is the total of all the words/letter values for this verse** preceded by the formula for the total, **(37 x 37) = 2701**.

NOTE: Numbers to remember when creating formulas: 1, 3, 7, 9, 11, 13, and all prime numbers that can only be divided by itself or the number 1. The ones used most in the more advanced codes are 3, 7, 11, 13, 37 and its reverse 73. Some of the other double numbers work as reverse numbers as well, such as 12 and 21. They begin to show up as you develop your skills in discovering the codes and get involved in the very advanced formulas. You need to love mathematics for going into it that far, but later lessons will take you through some of the examples that have been found.

e.g. Now take the total value of Genesis 1:1 - **2701** and **remove 37: 2701-37= 888 X 3**. (The sum is the value of **Jesus written in Greek X 3**) We will begin the Greek charts in lesson 2. In lesson 3 we will begin combining the Old and New Testaments codes with fascinating results. 888=Jesus, is in several of the Genesis 1:1 formulas. God presented Jesus right from the beginning! Shows definite connection between Old and New Testaments. Dr. Panin takes a given subject like the genealogy of Christ in Matthew 1:1-17, or a book of the Bible as a whole, or the Bible in its entirety, and shows the following kind of phenomenon.

1. The number of words in the vocabulary is divisible by 7.
 2. The number of words beginning with a vowel is divisible by 7.
 3. The number of words beginning with a consonant is divisible by 7.
 4. The number of words occurring in more than one form is divisible by 7.
 5. The number of words occurring in only one form is divisible by 7.
 6. The number of nouns is divisible by 7.
 7. Those words that are not nouns are divisible by 7.
 8. The number of proper names is divisible by 7.
 9. The male names are divisible by 7 and the female names are also divisible by 7.
 10. The number of words beginning with each of the letters of the alphabet is divisible by 7.
- These interesting facts barely scratch the surface of Dr. Panin's discoveries!
