### Replacement Theology – History

This is one of the most evil concepts promoted throughout the centuries, yet many Christians do not even realize this.

One thing is clear. Replacement theology is not a conviction based on research and study of scripture, but a state of mind plagued with centuries of dependence on tradition that is clouded with half-truths. This twisted history put thick scales on Middle Eastern eyes. Arab students are never taught Jewish history and they seldom look at scriptures for themselves; they are programmed by repetition of old propaganda to the point where they end up believing that they themselves hold divine truth.

God has only one faith to which He has called us, that is of being Spiritual Jews...no division regardless of where we live in the world... Christians should refer to themselves as Spiritual Jews.
