

NUMBER FOUR IN SCRIPTURE – CREATION/DOMINION

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DESCRIPTION:

CREATION – n. Act of forming or originating; universe

DOMINION – n. Supreme authority or control; territory subject to a ruler or government

VINE'S EXPOSITORY DICTIONARY OF NEW TESTAMENT WORDS:

CREATION: Ktizo, verb, used among the Greeks to mean the founding of a place, or city or colony, signifies in Scripture, to create, always of the act of God (*a*) whether in the natural creation, Mark 13:19; Romans 1:25 (where the title "The Creator" translates the article with the aorist participle of the verb); I Corinthians 11:9; Ephesians 3:9; Colossians 1:16; I Timothy 4:2; Rev. 4:11; 10:6, or (*b*) in the spiritual creation, Ephesians 2:10, 15; 4:24; Colossians 3:10.

DOMINION: Kratos, force, strength, might, more especially manifested power, is derived from a root, *kra*—, to perfect, to complete: "creator" is probably connected. It also signifies dominion, and is so rendered frequently in doxologies, I Peter 4:11; 5:11; Jude 25; Revelation 1:6; 16; and Hebrews 2:14, it is translated "power."

Note: Synonymous words are *bia, force,* often oppressive, *dunamis,* power; *exousia,* primarily liberty of action, then authority either delegated or arbitrary; *ischus,* strength, especially physical, power as an endowment.

Arbah [f.], arbahah [m.] Authority, government, rule, dominion, calendar, time, creation, kingdom, fullness, giving of the Torah (Law) and Holy Spirit.

- > Judah was **fourth** born son and had the sceptre of rule.
- 4 matriarchs
- ➤ 4 corners of the earth
- > 4 horns on the altar
- ➤ 4 tassels (tzit-tziyot) are to be worn on one's garment/robe
- 4 living creatures
- 4 horse men
- 4 rivers of Eden
- 4 winds
- 4 gospels and many more...

ON THE NEGATIVE SIDE:

- ➤ 4 beasts (Daniel 7:3)
- > Fourth one different from the others and has ten horns, later has 11 horns (Daniel 7:25)
- > Opposition to the calendar/clock/seasons/law that God gave on Day 4 of creation

Fourth Hebrew letter: **Dalet. Numerical value of 4**. Pictographic meaning door, draw out or in, knock, path, way, portal to heaven, dominion, control, bough and branch.

- Passover Seder is structured around **fours**: the **4** questions, the **4** sons and the **4** cups of wine.
- Seven loaves fed four thousand with 7 baskets of left over.
- On **Day 4 of creation**, the sun, moon and stars are placed in the sky (natural light) **to govern** the moedim (feast days). They **mark time** and **give signs**. Their light separates from darkness.
- God's calendar and prophetic clock were established on Day 4.
- The Jerusalem Council gave four basic requirements for Gentiles to enter the assembly. (Acts 15:19-21)
- Fourth Feast: Shavuot (Pentecost, Leviticus 23).
- Fourth Spirit of God: Ruach Adonai fullness of Holy Spirit (Isaiah 11:2)
- Fourth Church of Revelation: Thyatira (meaning perfume, odor of affliction, sacrifice of labor)
- NEGATIVE SIDE:
- A heart that devises wicked imaginations, becoming full of false light. (Proverbs 6:16-19)
- Giving authority to the beast and appetites of desire. Four also results in judgment, as in the four horsemen.

TIME AND AUTHORITY are intrinsically linked with Day 4.

- ✓ The mercy seat is a type of Throne, another picture of Authority and Government. Four Living Creatures surround the throne of Elohim, always declaring, "HOLY, HOLY, HOLY (3 times) is THE LORD GOD ALMIGHTY, WHO WAS AND WHO IS AND WHO IS TO COME." (Isaiah 6:3, Revelation 4:8)
- ✓ Both **four** and **seven** have many common elements. They depict holy places in both SPACE and TIME.
- ✓ Jesus is the door for the sheep (John 10:7-9) No other door or way is possible to enter into relationship with God.
